

Dean Worcester Memorial Cup

In honor of founding member Dean Worcester, we will be sailing for the perpetual trophy: a pewter stein Dean won in the Governors' cup.

START TIME: Between 1100 and 1105 GPS Time, note the time as you pass the buoy close aboard heading towards the first mark.

START PLACE: Green Can #1 off Whitehall Bay (L38-58.2N, 176-24.9W).

COURSE: From GC#1 WB to red channel buoy "86" north of Bloody Point (L 38-52.0N, 176-23.6W) to starboard; green outer West River entrance buoy #1 (L38-51.9N, 176-26.9W) to starboard;

FINISH: with red Annapolis Harbor #2 (L38-58.6N, 176-25.6W) close aboard to port . Take your own time and e-mail them to:

TIME LIMIT: 1600. One boat finishing makes it a race!

HANDICAP: If you haven't raced with CTSA before, contact us before the race with: your name, boat name, length on deck, waterline length, rig type, and propeller type (no. blades, fixed/folding).

SAILS: Spinnakers, gollywobblers, mizzen staysails, fishermen, water-sails are all OK.
