CTSA OLD SALT Race

Sunday, 8 September, 2013

CTSA OLD SALT RACE: The OLD SALT Race starts in the Miles River between HONALEE and GC "9". We'll hoist a white prep flag at 0950, a blue warning flag at 0955, and a red start flag at 1000.

START: The course is a simple one. Take R"4" FI R 4S off Tilghman Point to port, G"1" FI G 4S off Kent Point to starboard, Bloody Point Bar Light FI 6S to starboard, and R"6" FI (2+1) off Saunders Point to port within 100 yards. With R"6" abeam, take your own time and phone it in to HONALEE (410.923.4424) or call on VHF 68.

We will monitor VHF 68 throughout the race unless the chatter from other boats gets annoying. Our cell phone is always on.
