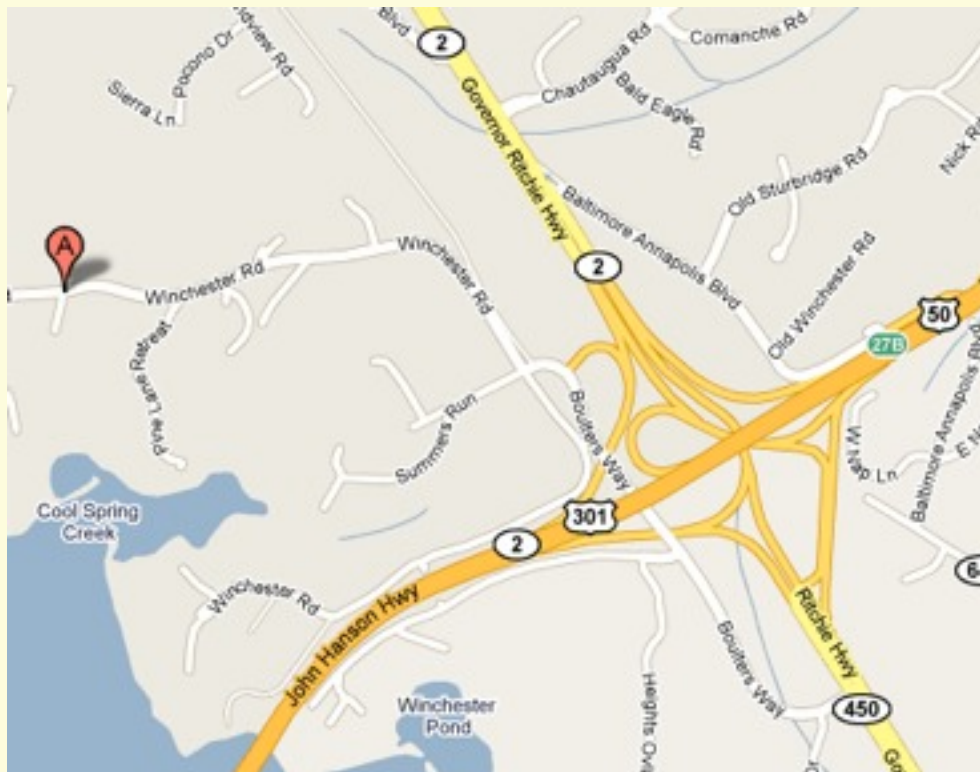
**WRITTEN DIRECTIONS

Cross the Severn River Bridge and take Exit 27 and bear right toward Naval Academy/Route 450. Take the first right onto Boulters Way. Go approximately 1/2 mile to the stop sign. Turn right onto Winchester Road. Go 1/2 mile to white pillars flanking driveway and house on left.

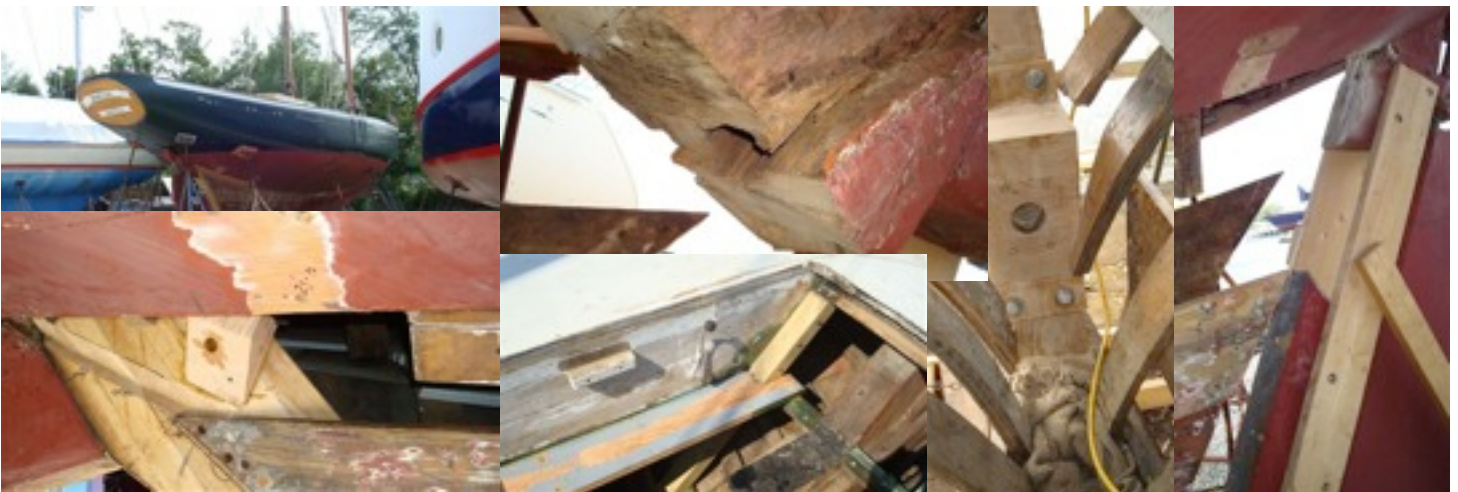
**From the Naval Academy:**

Go north and across the Naval Academy Bridge. Turn left onto Boulters Way. Go approximately 1/2 mile to the stop sign. Turn right onto Winchester Road. Go 1/2 mile to white pillars flanking driveway and house on left.
