Greetings All,

Are you ready for the 5th Annual Three Lights Race???...Ready or not, CTSA's first race of the season should be a great way to scrub some of the winter barnacles off the bottom of your boat!

This year's race will again start Saunder's Point Light, head over to round the main channel 84A, then to 86, passing near Bloody Point Bar Light, then over to GR "SR", which will take you close by Thomas Point Light. The finish will be at South River nun buoy #2. It promises to be a very scenic race, and the weather (we're told) will be in the 70's with perfect wind!

Attached is the race course sheet. If you have never raced with CTSA before, to get a rating please contact Paul Miller via email @ dawnpaulmiller@comcast.net) or via phone @ 410-293-6441 and he will take your measurements (actually your boat's). At the end of the race, please also supply Paul with your finish time (off the GPS clock) and he will calculate the results.

After the race we expect there will be a raft up in Harness Creek, which borders Quiet Waters Park.

Like last year, HONALEE (Paul and Dawn's boat) will be the start boat...

CTSA Three Lights Race

Saunders Pt Light - Bloody Pt Bar Light - Thomas Pt Light For Classic Sailboats - 21st May 2011

1100 (GPS time): Warning Signal (Yellow Flag)

1105: Prep Signal (Blue Flag)

1110 Start (Red Flag)

Start Line: Saunder's Point Light (2+1 flasher between South and West Rivers). Between

the light and Honalee's mainmast.

First Mark: Red Channel Marker 84A (leave to your port side) Second Mark: Red Channel Marker 86 (leave to your port side)

Third Mark: Green/Red Channel Marker "SR" next to Thomas Point Light (leave to your

port side)

Finish: South River Red Nun 2 bearing 000 magnetic from your boat, within 100 yards.

Total Distance = 14.6 NM (Send Paul your finish time!)

Raft up in Harness Creek afterwards! Listen to VHF Ch. 68 for changes!
