# CTSA OLD SALT Race Sunday, 11 September, 2011

<u>CTSA OLD SALT RACE</u>: We've reversed it this year! Our annual race will go from the Miles RIver to Saunders Point. Course Details follow. For more information, please contact Chris White at 401.353.1201.

**START:** 1000 – Between INTERLUDE and BOUY "8" in the Miles River. The ten minute warning is at 0950 (white flag); the five minute warning, at 0955 (blue flag); race start at 1000 (red flag).

#### COURSE (REVERSE OF PREVIOUS YEARS):

R"6" AND R"4" off Tilghman Point to port.

Take G"1" off Kent Point to starboard.

Take Bloody Point Light to starboard.

**FINISH:** Within 150 feet abeam of the quick flash light off Saunders Point.

Take your own finish time and call it in to INTERLUDE. INTERLUDE will monitor Channel 68. Her cell phone is 410.353.1201.

- Any boat under 60 feet in length, whose hull is built from wood and whose design dates back before 1970 may enter. This includes newer wooden boats built to pre-1970 designs.
- The deadline to enter was September 1, 2011 with a \$25 registration fee. That said, you probably can still enter after the 1st, but will have to contact <u>nshof.org</u> for more details.
