
## The Annual CTSA Icebreaker is almost here... Let it NOT snow, Let it NOT snow, Let it NOT snow!!!

#### From MD route 178 (Generals' Hwy):

- # Go EAST (down the hill towards the river) on Herald Harbor Road (MD 465)
- **\*\*** Turn RIGHT onto River Road when Herald Harbor Road ends
- \* Take first LEFT onto Palisades Blvd
- \* White residence is approximately .5 mile on RIGHT (Steep driveway, probably boats around)
- \* Physical Address: 509 Palisades Blvd., Crownsville, MD 21032 (indicated by "A" on map)
