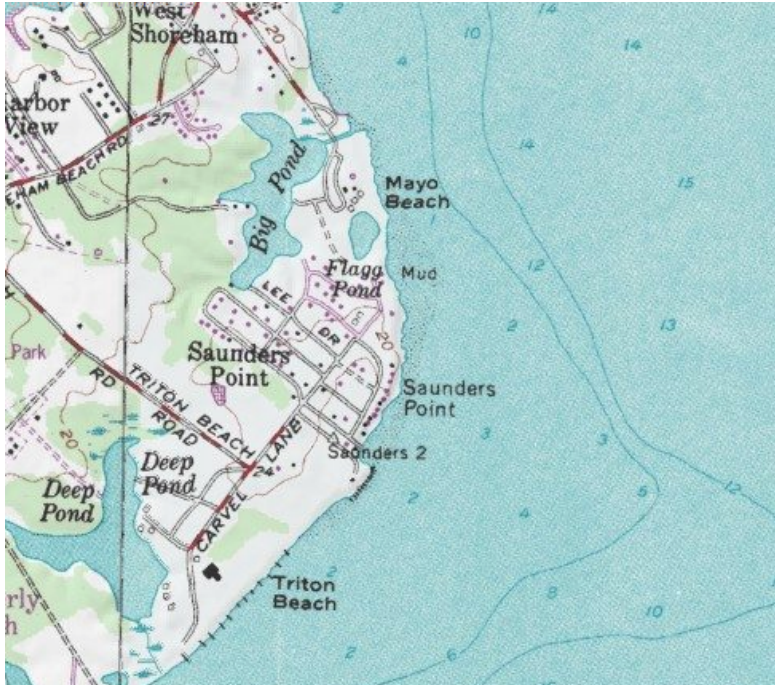

CTSA Three Lights Fiasco

Saunders Pt Light – Bloody Pt Bar Light – Thomas Pt Light
For Classic Sailboats – **10 May 2014**

1050 (GPS time): Warning Signal (Yellow Flag)

1055: Prep Signal (Blue Flag)

1100 Start (Red Flag)

Start Line: Saunders Point Light (2+1 flasher between South and West Rivers). Between the light and either Honalee or Sprite (a 15' Lyman).

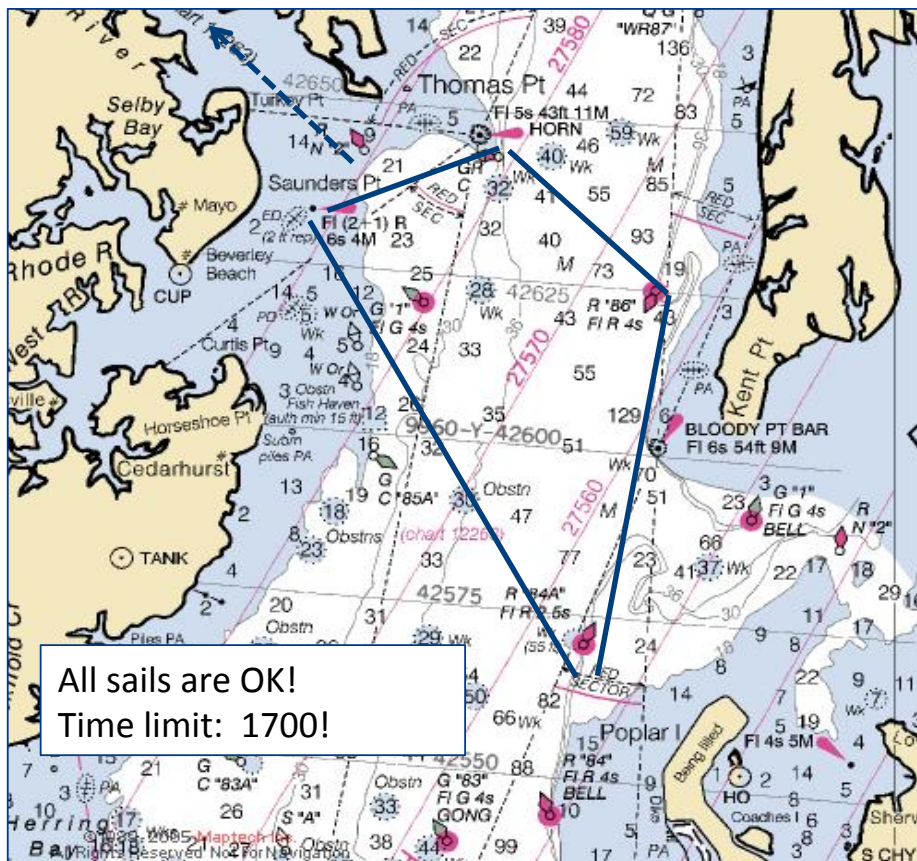
- Red Channel Marker 84A (leave it to the north)
- Red Channel Marker 86 (leave it to the west)
- Green/Red Channel Marker "SR" (leave it to the south)

Finish: when Saunders's Point Light is within 50 yards and bears due South.

Official Distance = 15 NM (e-mail Paul your finish time!)

Raft up in Harness Creek afterwards! Listen to VHF Ch. 68 for changes!

Important Note!
You may round the marks in any order or direction!

Join ELF and other classic sailing yachts for the 4th annual ELF Classic Yacht Race in 2014 – a true yachtsman’s race. The Eastport Yacht Club in Annapolis will serve as the departure point for this sailing classic to the Chesapeake Bay Maritime Museum in St. Michaels, scheduled for Saturday, May 17, 2014.

This Classic Yacht Restoration Guild event recreates the traditions of yacht racing of the 1880’s when the races began on shore, included rowing to the boat on mooring or anchor, making sail and reversing the process at the finish, signing the race log at the Tolchester Bandstand on the grounds of the Chesapeake Bay Maritime Museum.
